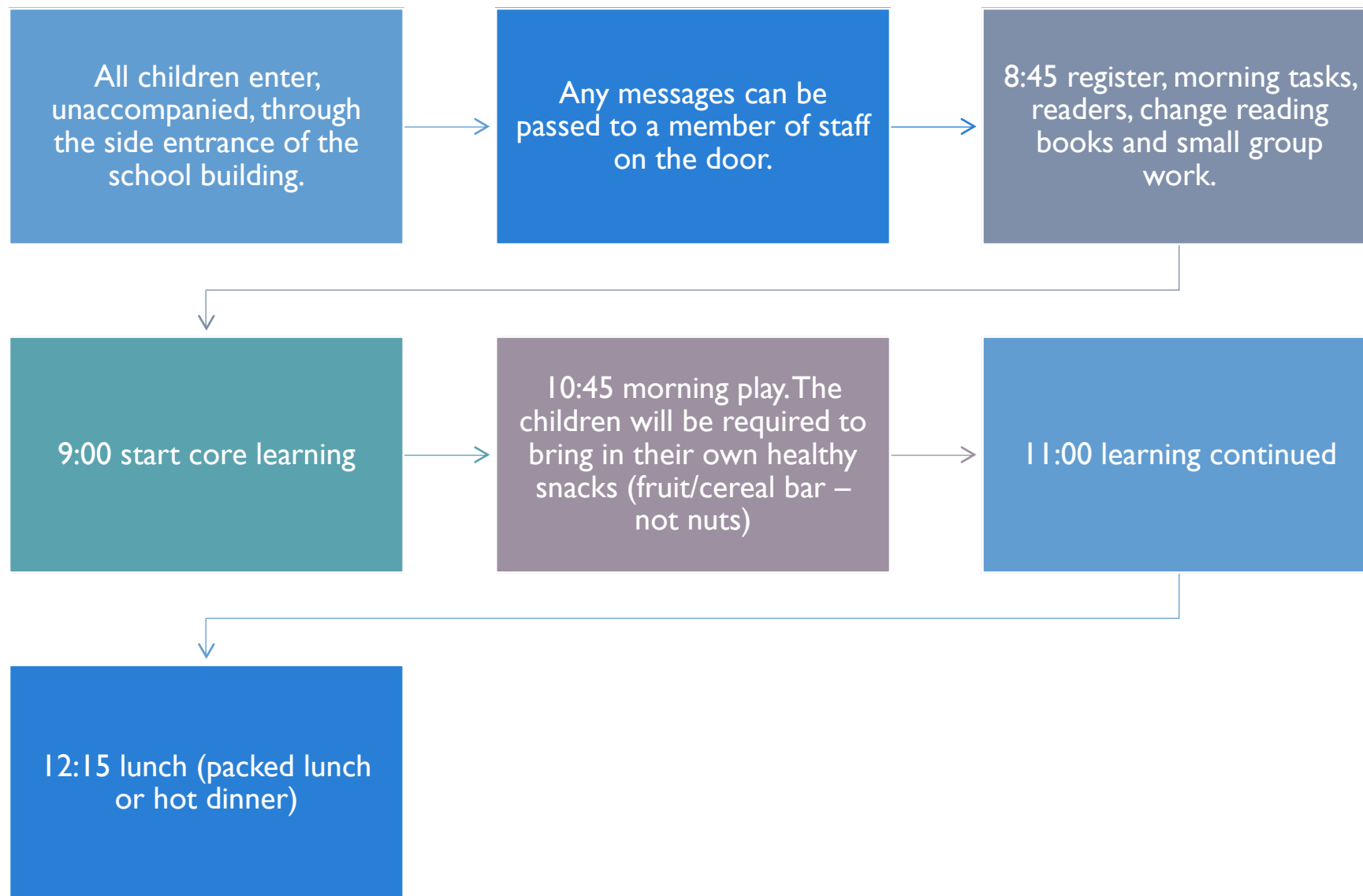

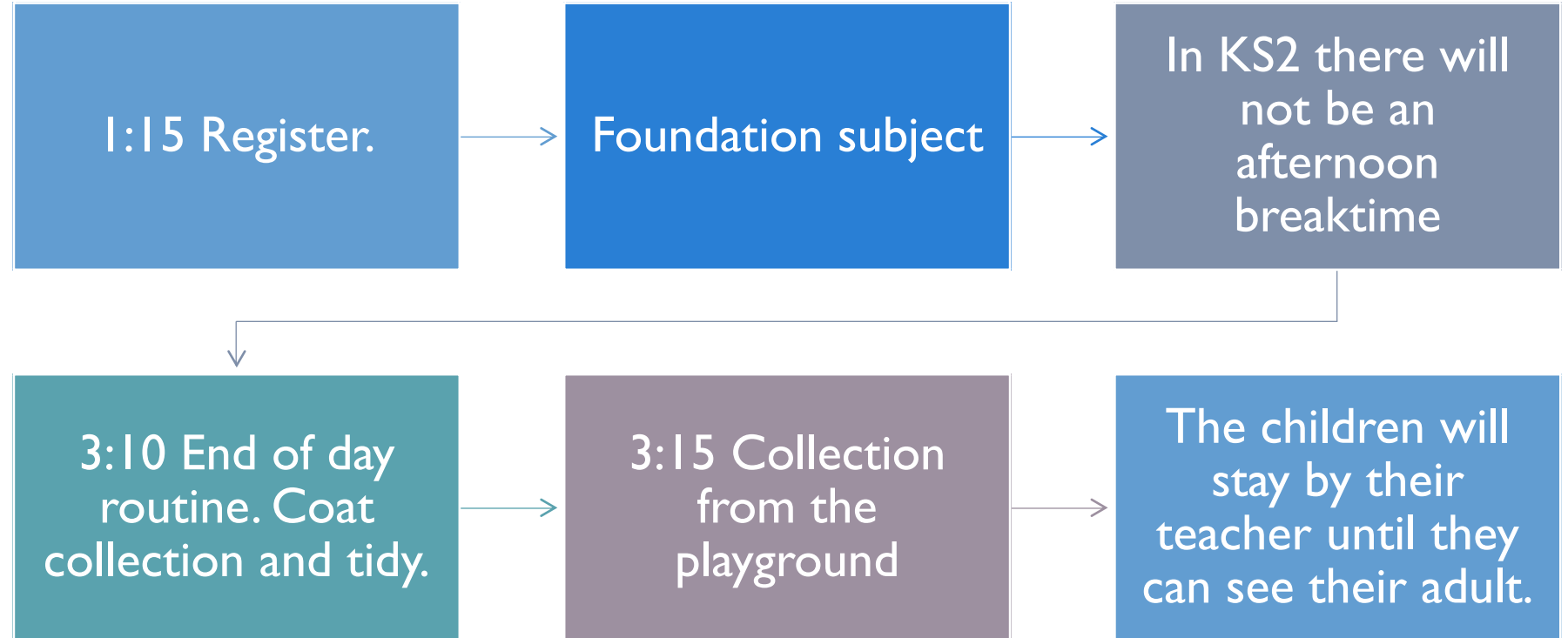

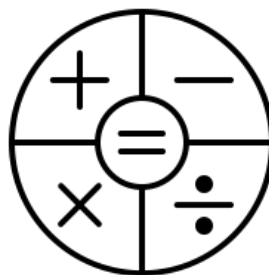
CURRICULUM

English

Maths

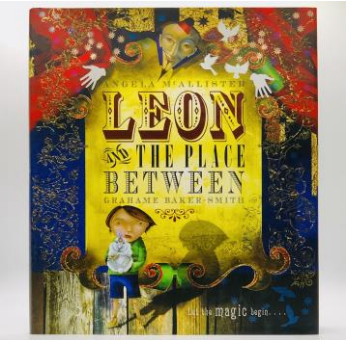

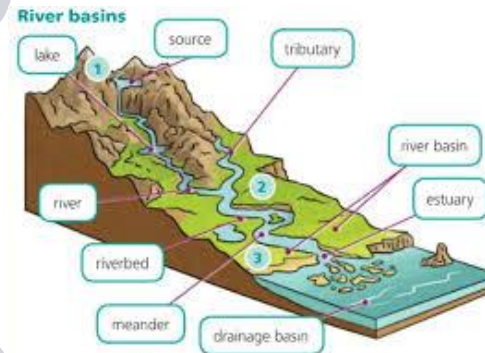
Topic

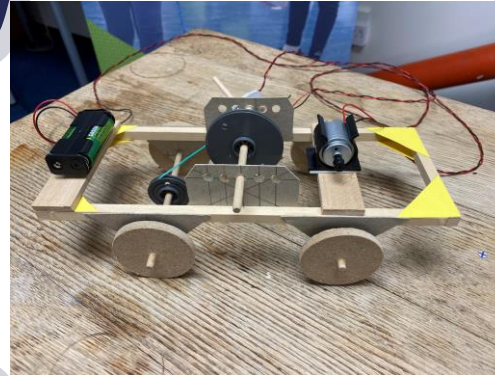

SPENCER PARK

On Thursday, the children will spend their lunchtime at Spencer Park.

Please ensure that your child has appropriate clothing and footwear for walking and playing at the park.

Children will require a packed lunch on this day. If your child has a school meal on this day they will be provided with a packed lunch.



P.E KIT

- Plain white or navy t-shirt (school logo is optional).
- Plain black or navy shorts.
- Pumps or trainers.
- Plain navy, grey, or black tracksuit or jogging trousers and a sweatshirt over their P.E kit during the winter months.
- No football kits.
- No jewellery.

- Outdoor PE is on **Thursday** for 5W and **Tuesday** for 5T (children to come into school wearing kit).

- Indoor PE is on **Monday** for 5W and **Friday** for 5T (children to keep a pair of shorts in school to change into).

PE kit should be worn on your child's outdoor PE day.

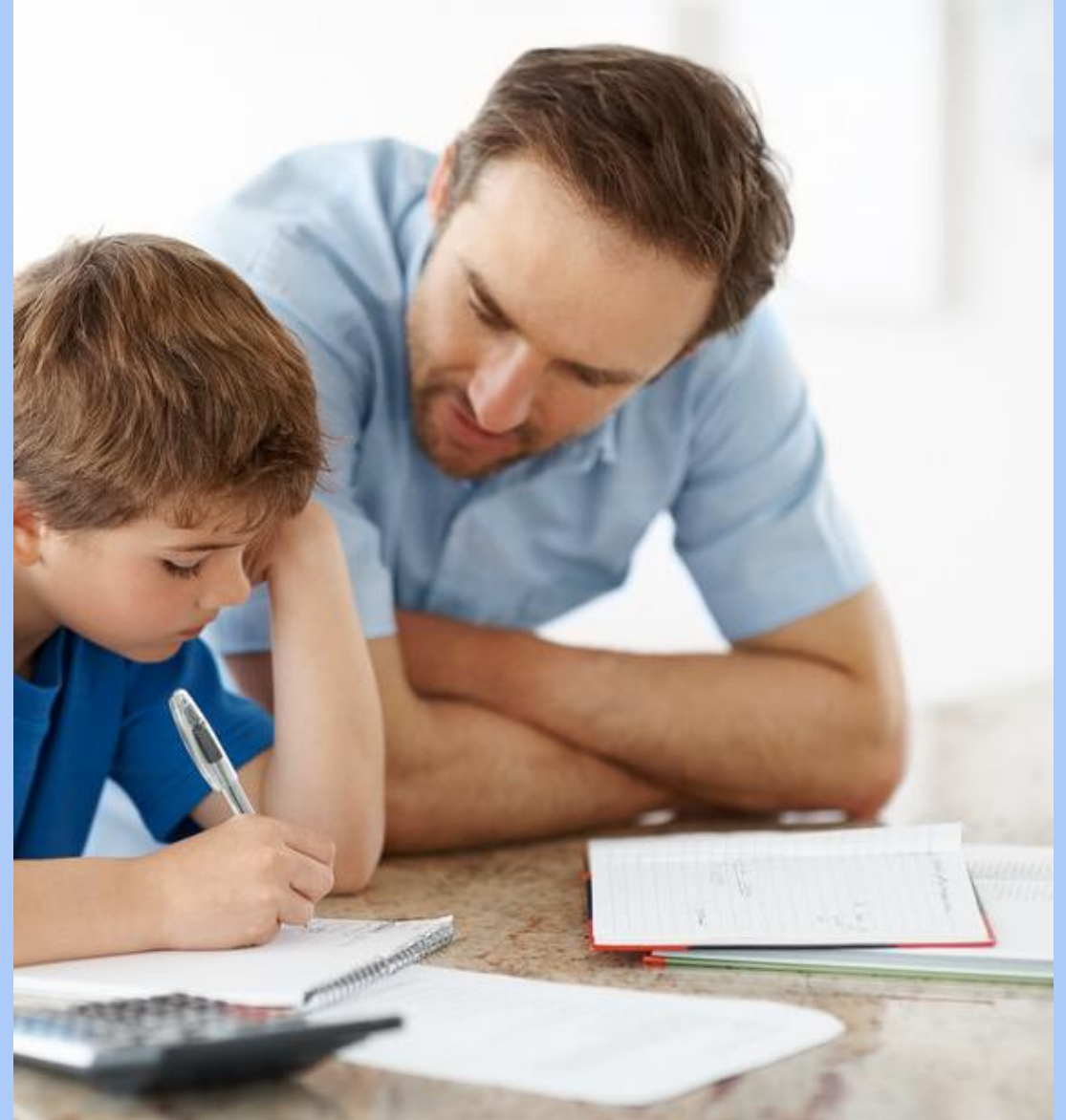


THINGS TO TAKE HOME

Reading books can be taken home throughout the week however they should be brought back into school every day.

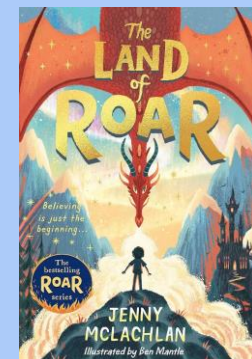
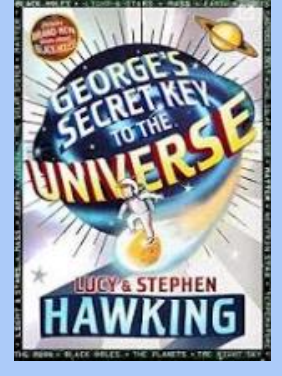
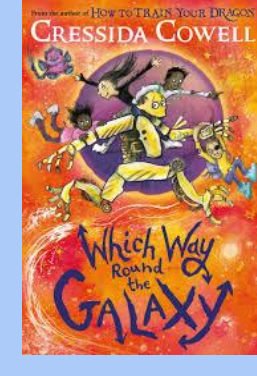
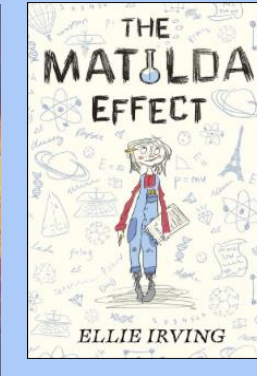
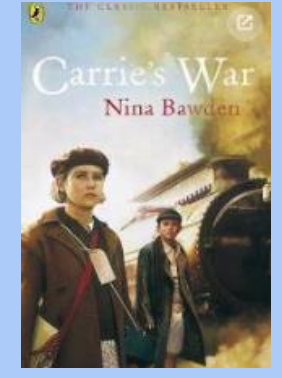
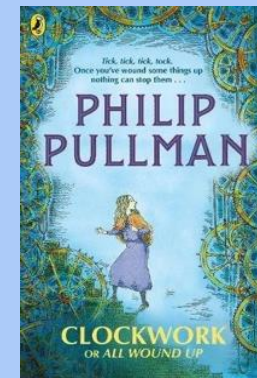


READING

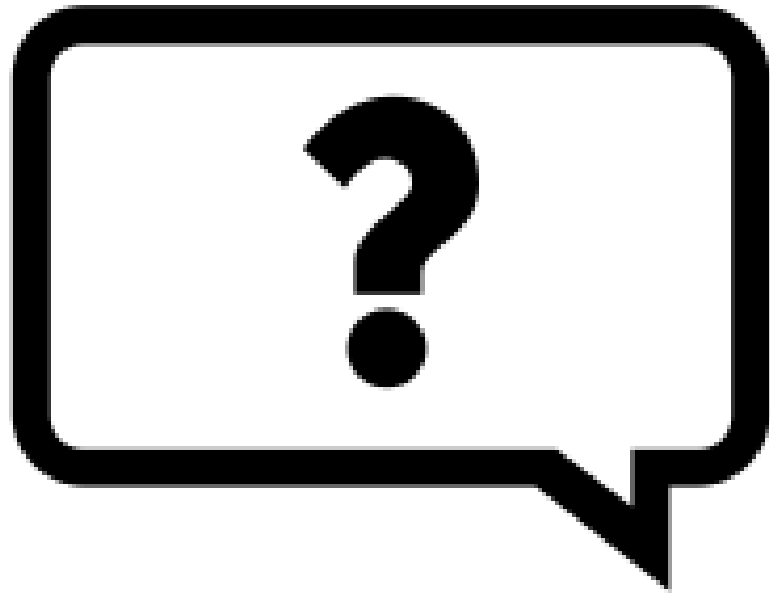
