- Homework will include SATs practice.

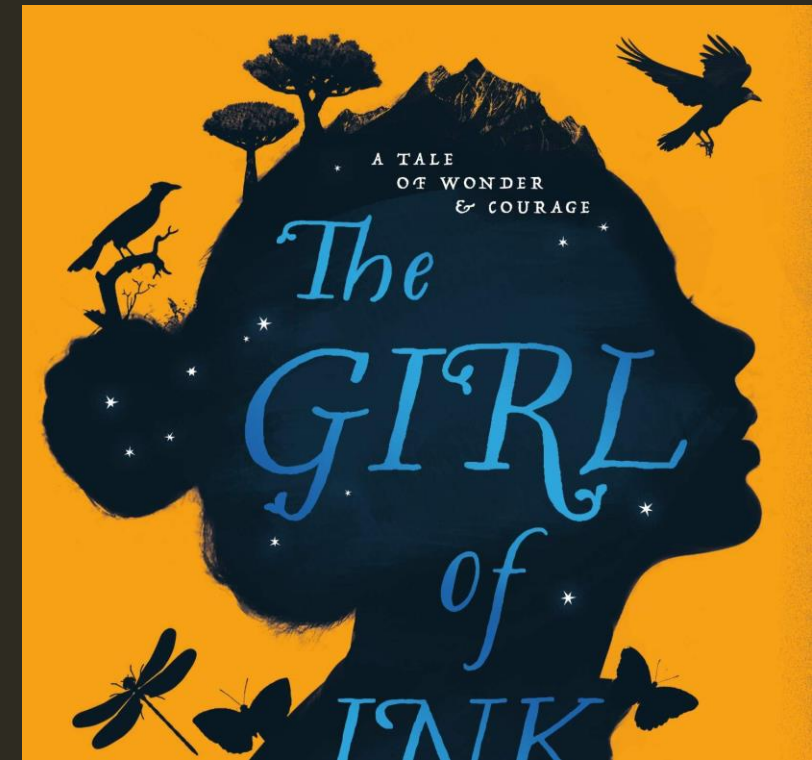
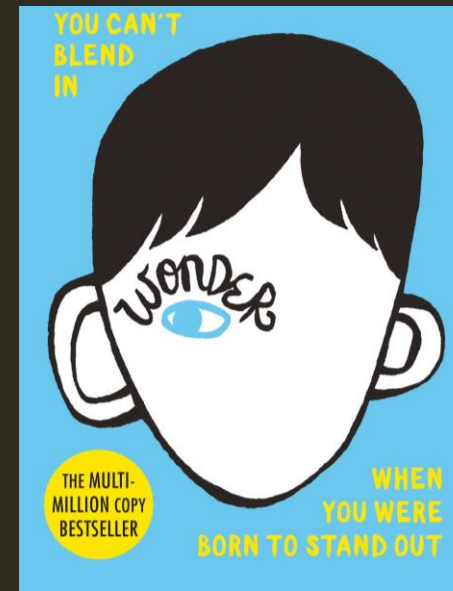
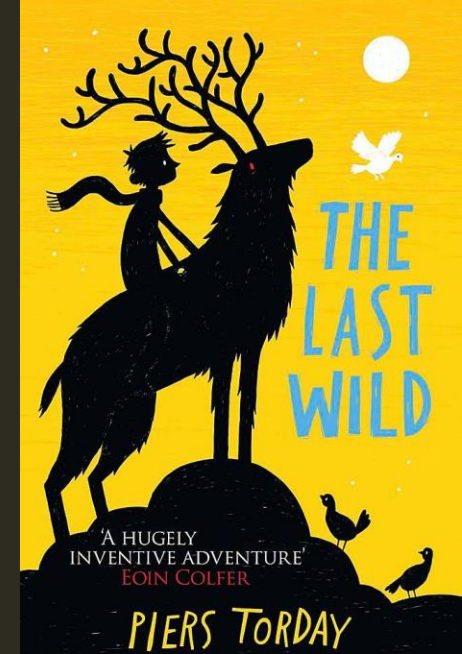
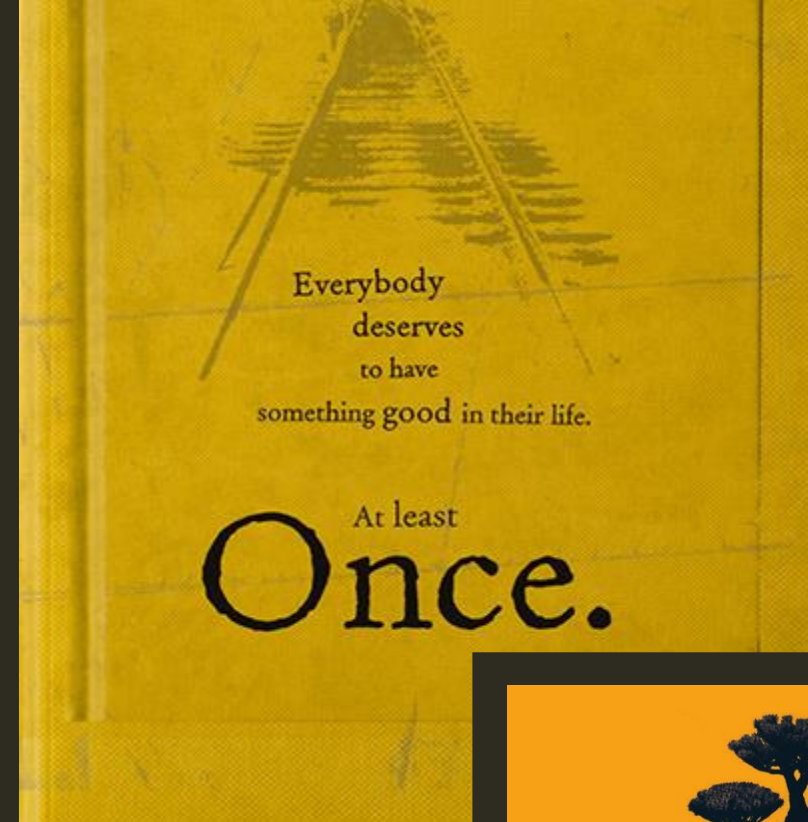
