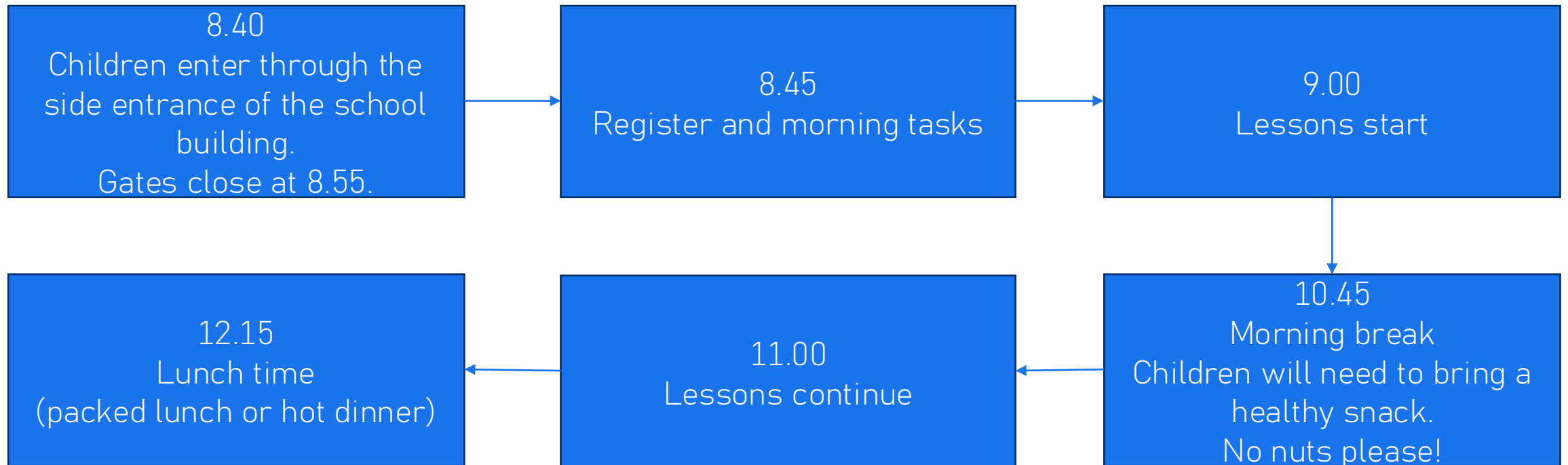

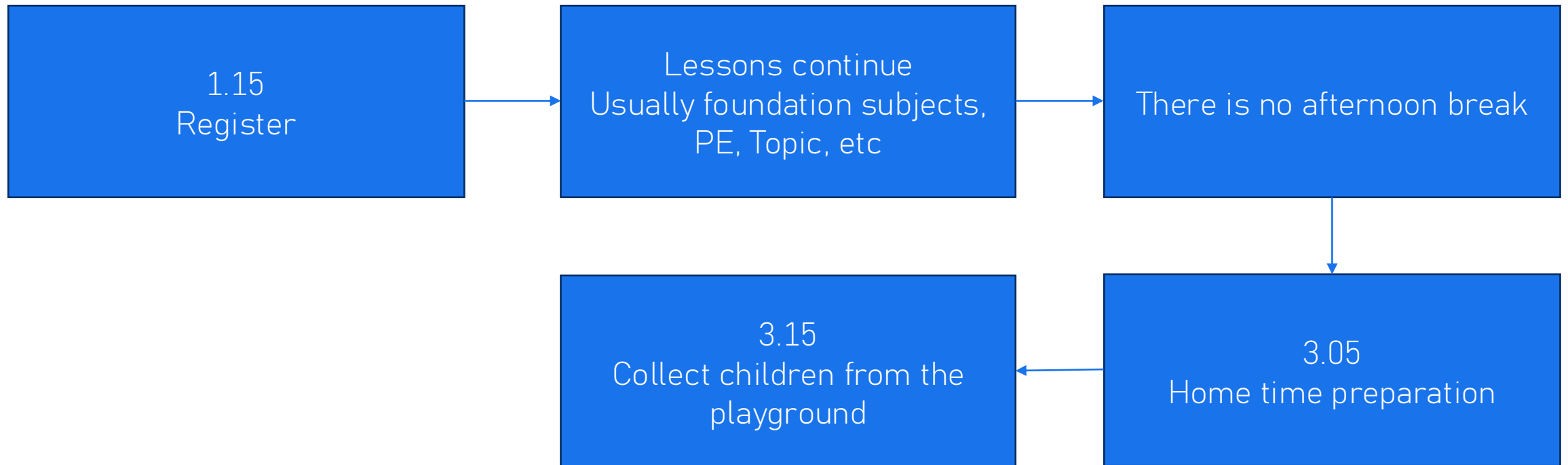

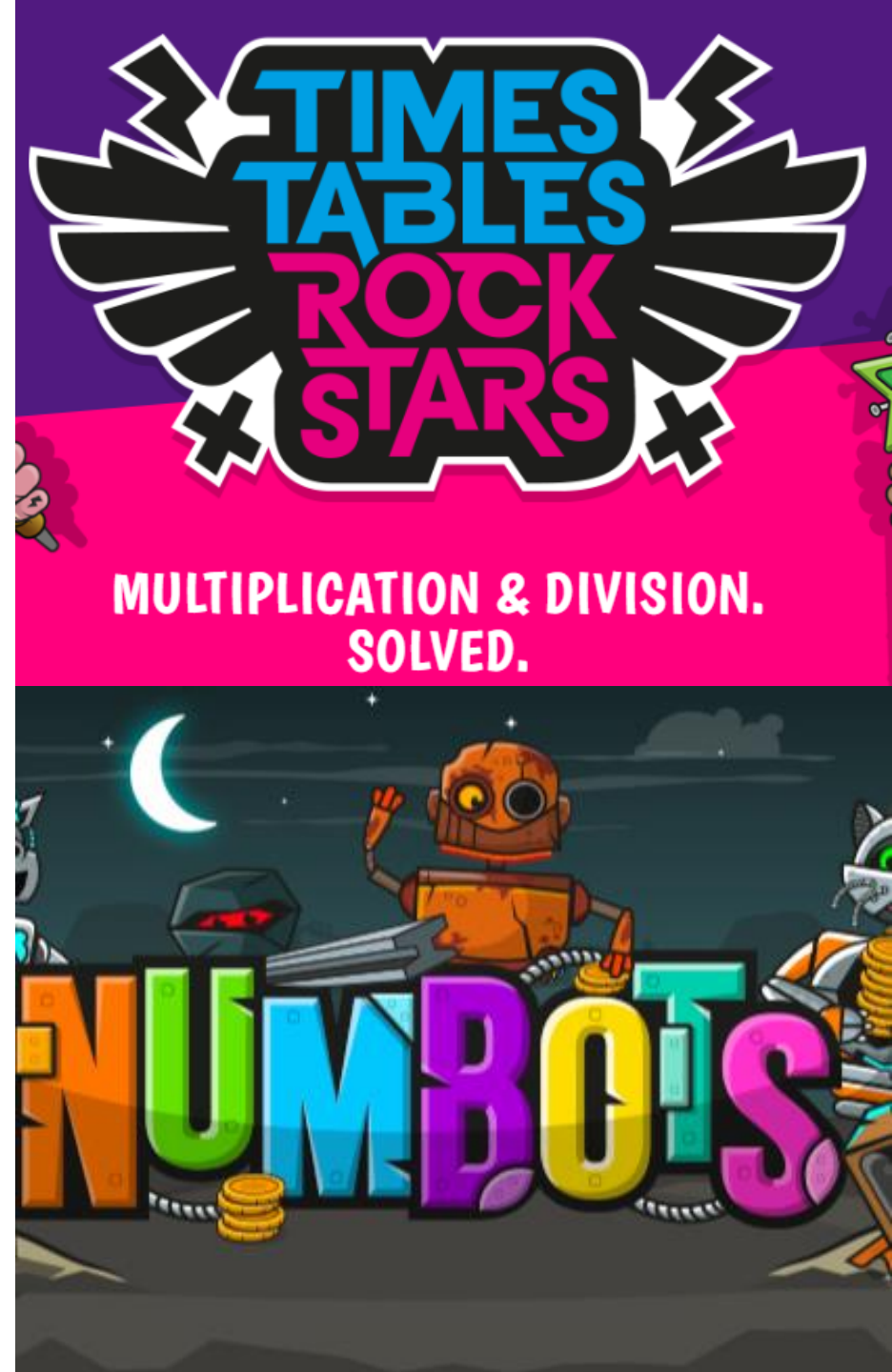

# Times Table Rock Stars and Numbots
