Pop-up Library

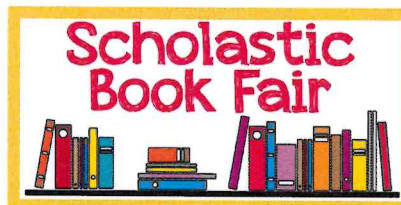
