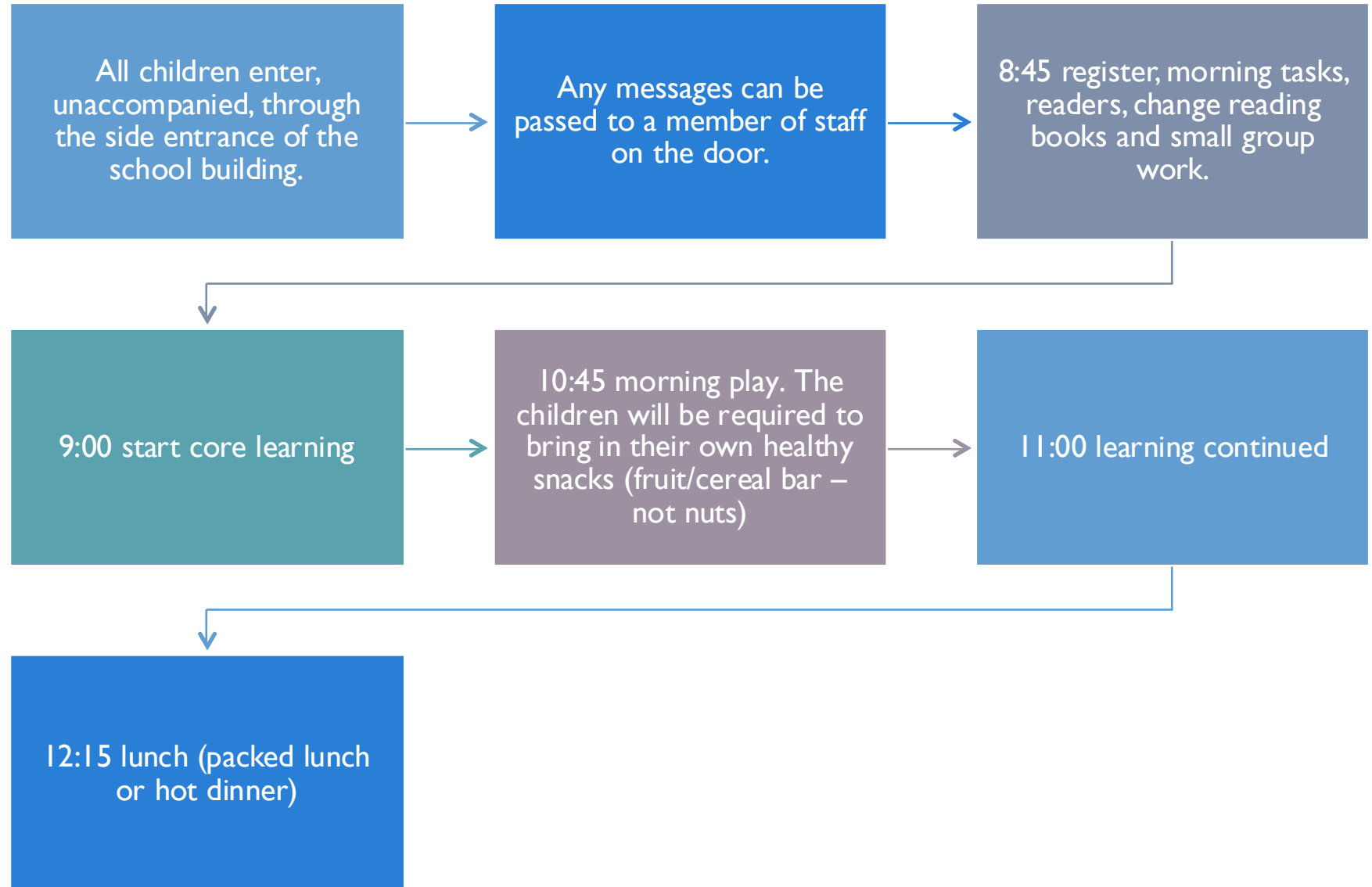

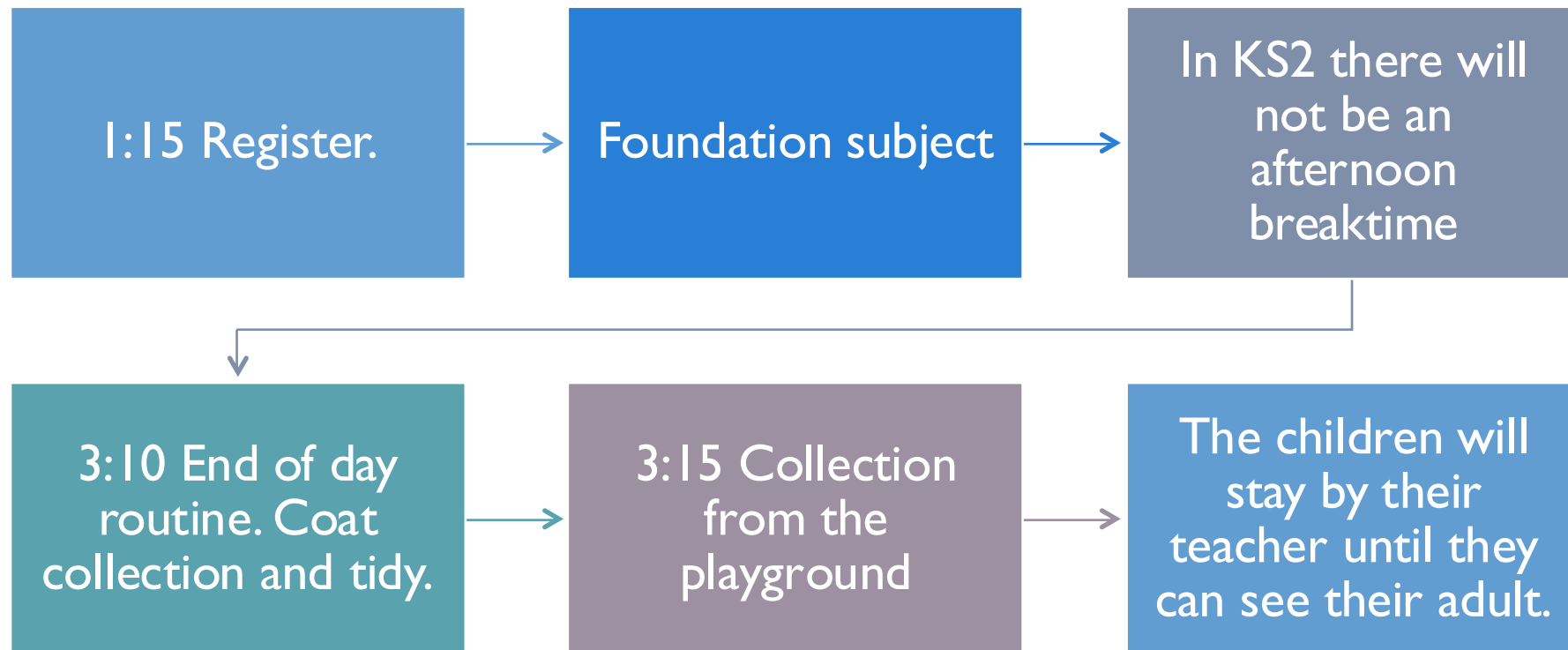

CURRICULUM

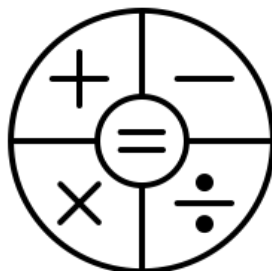
English

The children will continue to develop their fiction and non-fiction writing skills using the Ready Steady Write primary writing scheme. In addition, they will have spelling and handwriting lessons during the week, along with reading fluency and comprehension lessons.



Maths

The children will use a mixture of 'Maths No Problem' and 'Oak Academy' resources. This year, Maths Journals will be used to record all maths learning. They will also be able to access challenges which enable them to apply their skills in different contexts. In addition, they will have daily Mastering Number lessons to improve their maths fluency skills.



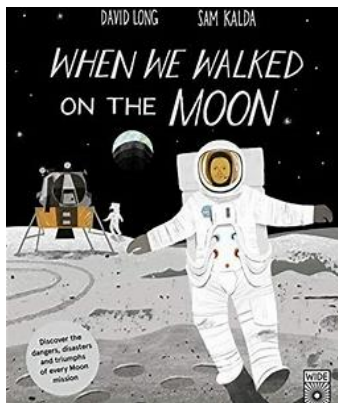
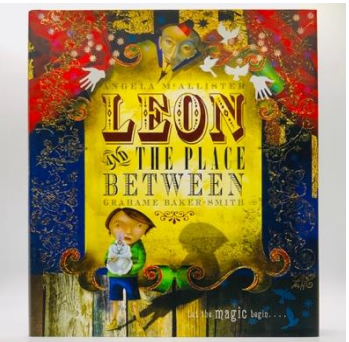
Topic

The children will study the foundation subjects through our termly themes. These include: science, history, geography, art, computing and design & technology. They will also have PE, world views, PSHE, music and Spanish (MFL) lessons.

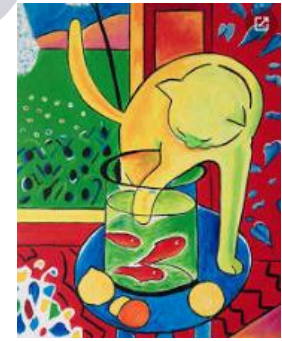


READING FLUENCY LESSONS

- Every week, the children will work on their group reading texts three times per week.
- They will take the book home that they are working on (they may have this book for 2-3 weeks) but it should come back into school every day.
- They may read (re-read) the chapter(s) they have already read in school, but should avoid going on and reading further before the next lesson. They will build fluency by re-reading familiar texts that they have already looked at.
- Please note that there will be a charge for any lost books. These books cost £12-£13 to replace.
- Children will also choose a free choice book, which they can bring home. We would like to encourage the children to read as widely as possible and to try to choose a new genre to try at least once a term.

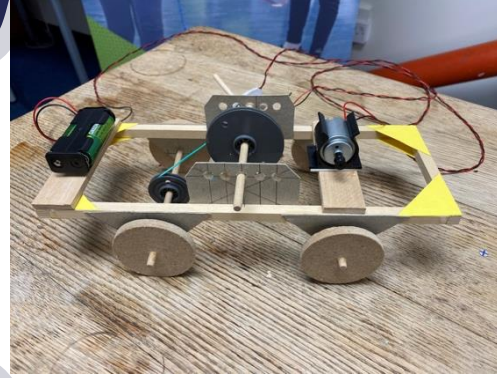


WHAT DO WE LEARN IN YEAR 5? AUTUMN TERM

SPENCER PARK

On most Tuesdays, the children will spend their lunchtime at Spencer Park.

Please ensure that your child has appropriate clothing and footwear for walking and playing at the park.

Children will require a packed lunch on this day. If your child has a school meal, they will be provided with a packed lunch.



P.E KIT

- Plain white or navy t-shirt (school logo is optional).
- Plain black or navy shorts.
- Pumps or trainers.
- Plain navy, grey, or black tracksuit or jogging trousers and a sweatshirt over their P.E kit during the winter months.
- No football kits.
- No jewellery.

- Indoor PE is on a **Monday** for 5T and **Tuesday** for 5SK (children keep a pair of shorts/pumps in school to change into).

- Indoor PE is on **Friday** for both 5SK and 5T (children come to school in PE kit – this should be black/navy shorts/joggers and white t-shirt).



THINGS TO BRING IN

The children will need to bring a water bottle each day (not too large as they can be refilled during the day).

The children will need to bring in their own healthy snacks for their morning break.

Reading books (every day).

PE kit should be worn on your child's outdoor PE day.

Appropriate clothing/footwear for allotment days.

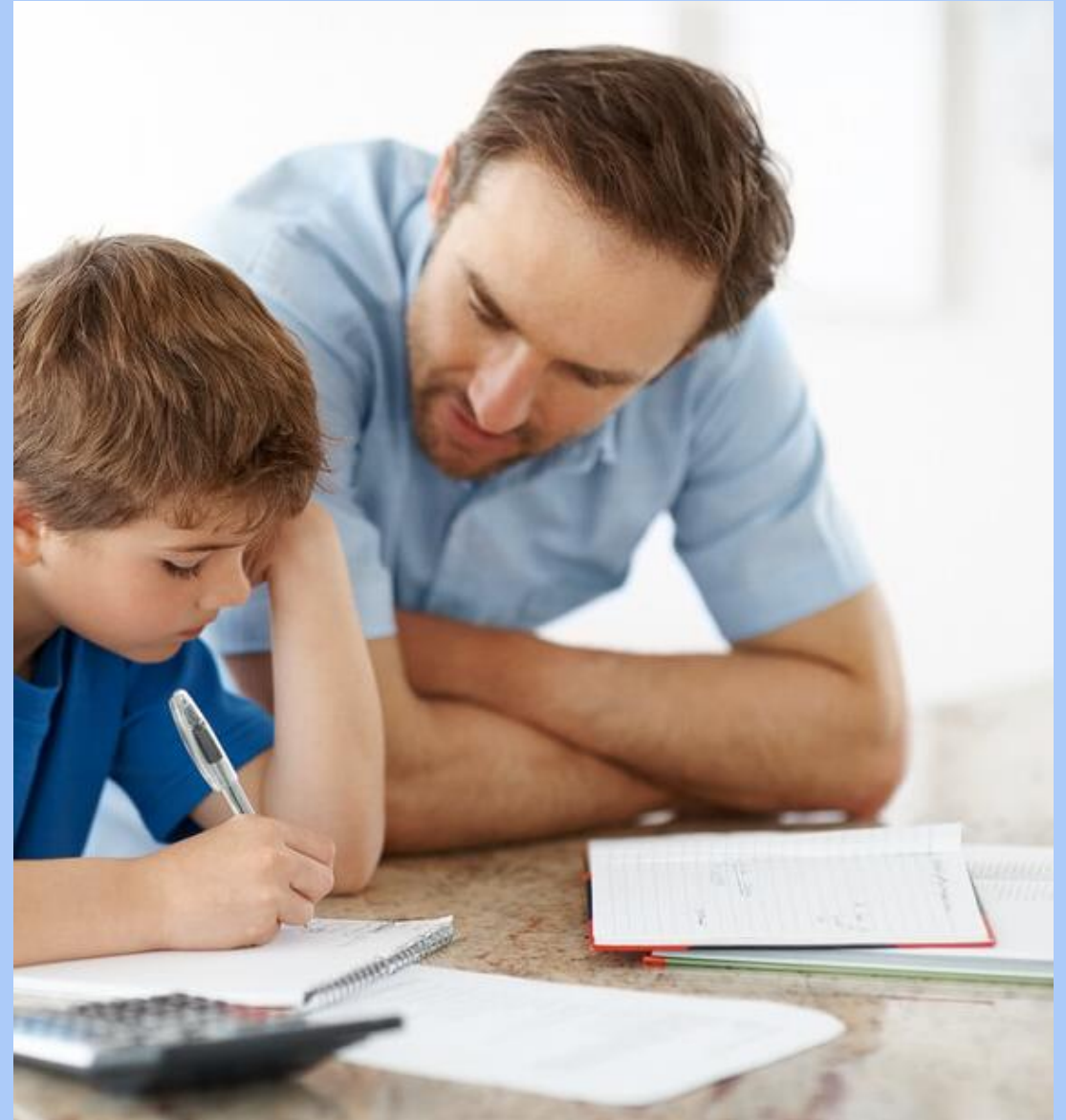


THINGS TO TAKE HOME

Homework books are given out on a Friday (fortnightly) and the children will receive a subject specific task.

We kindly ask that homework books are returned by the Wednesday of the 2nd week, so it gives us time to look at them ready for the Friday. Children will receive stickers and house points for good quality/exceptional/creative homework.

Reading books can be taken home throughout the week however they should be brought back into school every day.

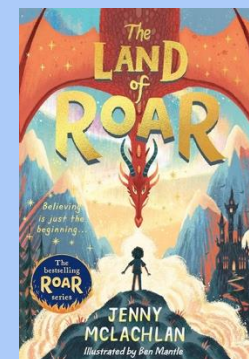
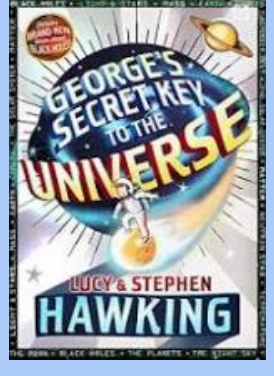
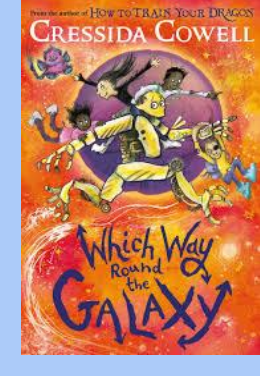
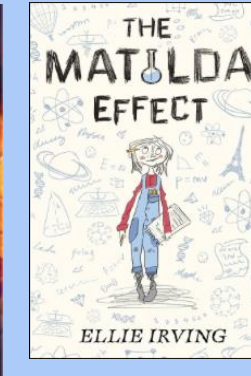
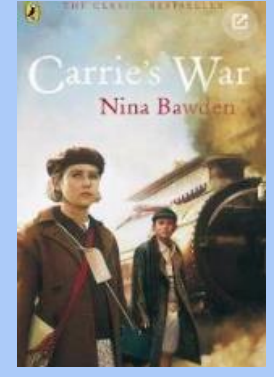
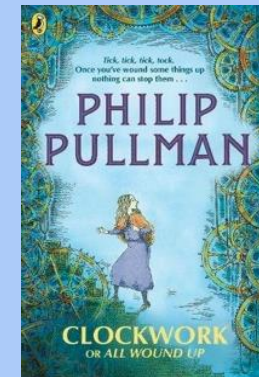


READING

TTRS

- Your child will have a TTRS login and password (You will have received a letter with your child's details and you will also find their login stuck in the front of their homework book).
- Please encourage your child to practice their times tables using this APP. The TTRS password also works for the Numbots APP, which reinforces basic number skills e.g. addition and subtraction.
- We suggest about 20-25 minutes each week as a minimum.

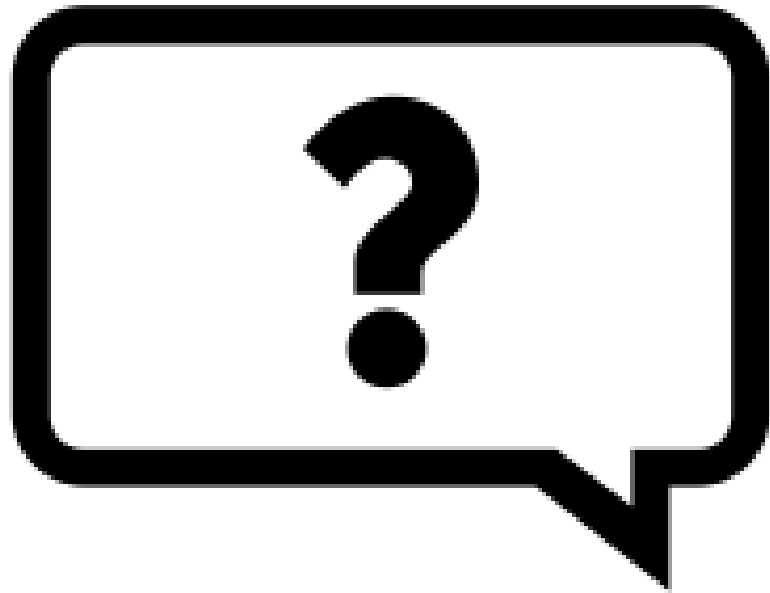
